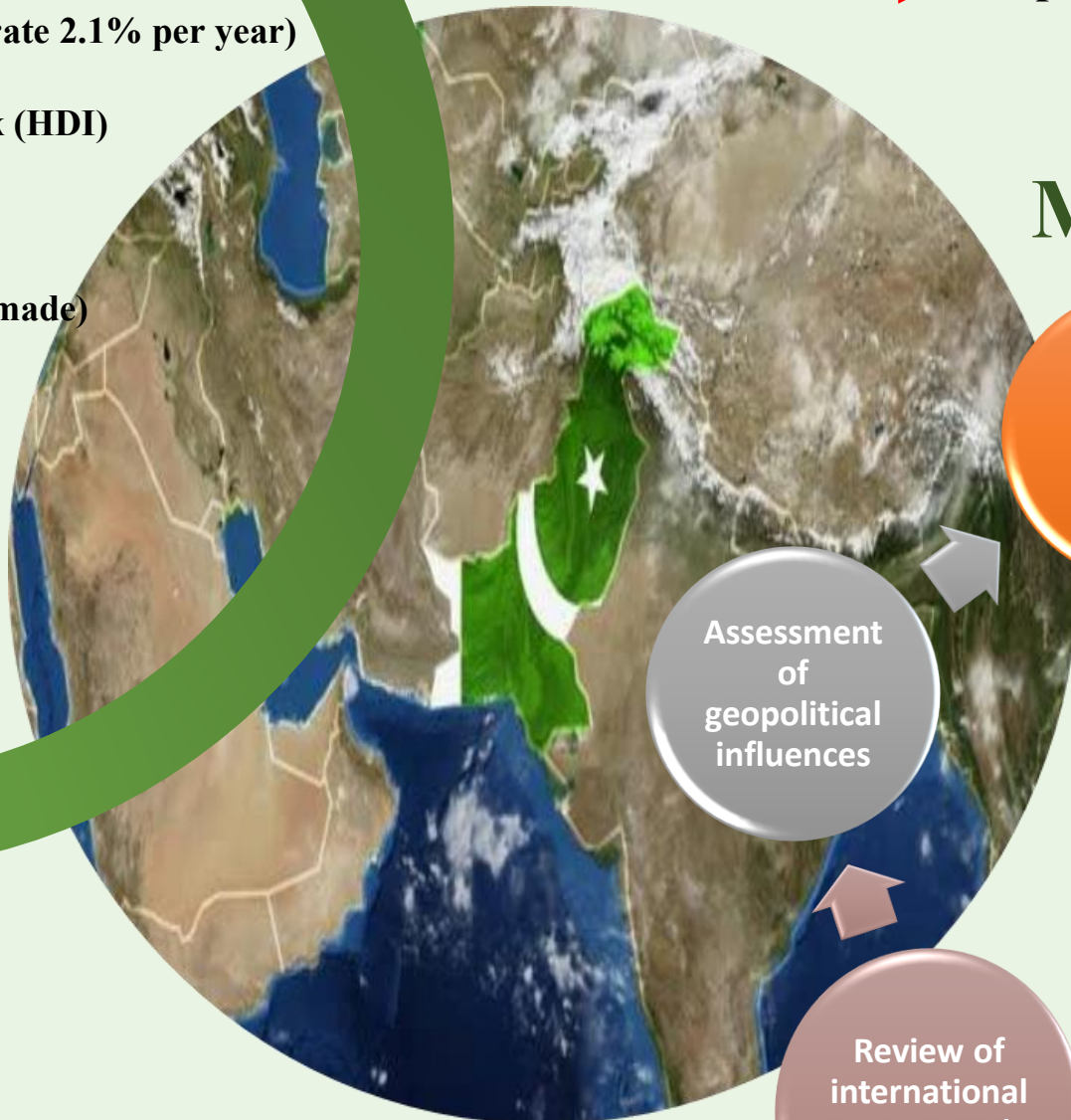

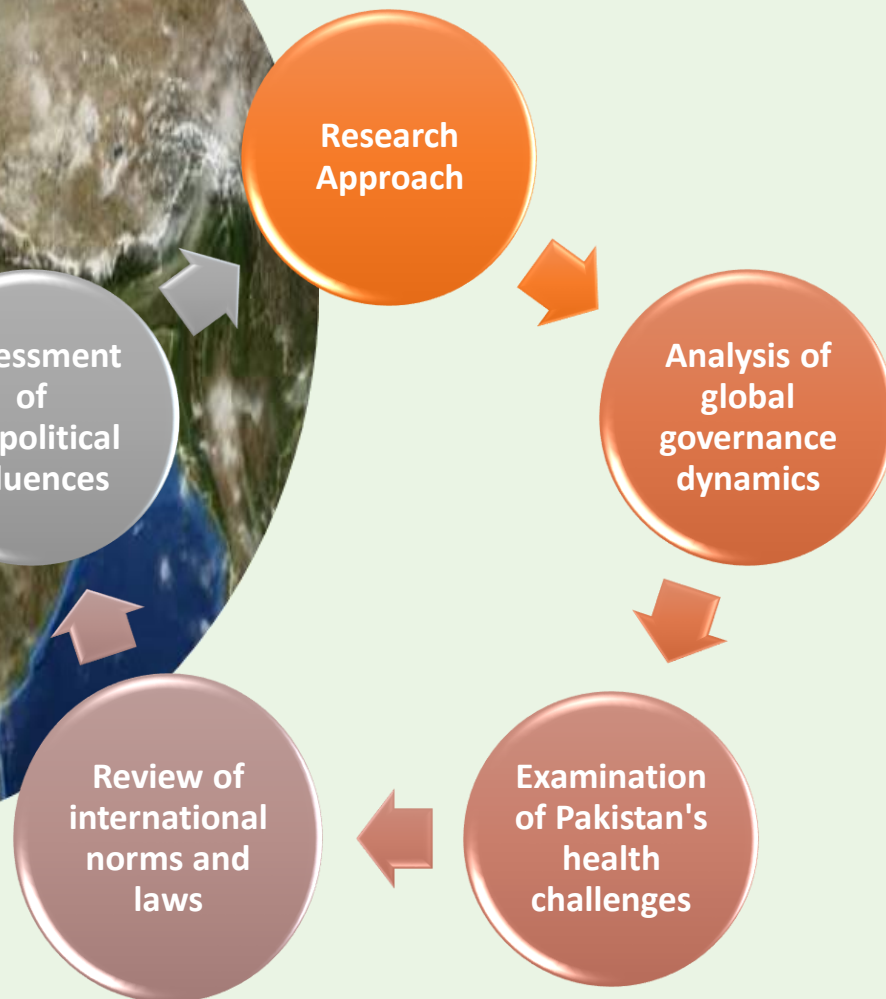
## Introduction
